PLEASE READ ALL RULES CAREFULLY.

- 1. A contestant may enter one or more wines in all lots.
- 2. Contestants must be 21 years or older as of the date of the fair.
- 3. All wines must be homemade by an amateur.
- 4. Supervisors reserve the right to combine a lot having less than three entries with another lot.
- 5. All wines and beer entered must list major ingredient (type grape, type vegetable, the berry or mead). All beers entered must list major ingredients (grain, hops, type of yeast, water)
- 6. All entries submitted for showing and judging must be homemade. No individual or any member of the group of the submitted entry shall be involved with commercial wine or beer making. Any wine or beer that may be legally sold is not considered eligible.
- 7. Wines must be bottled in standard wine bottles, at least 16 ounces. Beer must be bottled in 12 ounce or larger bottles with all labels removed and all bottles should be securely capped or corked. No decanters will be accepted.
- 8. Wine will be judged on taste/texture, appearance, aroma/bouquet, aftertaste and overall impression. Beer will be judged on taste, aroma, and appearance.
- 9. All entries will be stored at room temperature until prior to the competition when the beer will be chilled to proper serving temperature. Wines will be judged at room temperature.
